

PROCEEDINGS OF COMMON COUNCIL.

ADJOURNED SESSION—JULY 27, 1891.

The Common Council of the City of Indianapolis met in the Council Chamber, Monday evening, July 27th, A. D. 1891, at 8:00 o'clock, in adjourned session.

PRESENT—W. M. Hicklin, President *pro tem.* of the Common Council in the Chair, and 18 members, viz: Councilmen Austin, Burns, Cooper, Coy, Dunn, Gauss, Markey, Martindale, Murphy, Myers, Nolan, Olsen, Pearson, Rassmann, Sherer, Sweetland, Trusler, and Weber.

ABSENT, 6—viz: Councilmen Davis, Gasper, McGill, Stechhan, Woollen, and President Yontz.

ORDINANCES ON SECOND READING.

On motion, the following entitled ordinance was read the second time:

G. O. No. 27, 1891—An ordinance approving a certain contract, granting the right to lay and maintain a switch or side-track across Kentucky avenue, in the City of Indianapolis, Ind.

Councilman Weber offered the following amendment; which was adopted:

Amend Section one, by adding: *Provided*, That the work of constructing the building by said Deere & Co, for the partial accommodation of which company this ordinance is passed, be commenced within thirty (30) days from the passage and taking effect of this ordinance, and that the work of construction be promptly pushed to completion.

The above entitled ordinance—G. O. No. 27, 1891—was then ordered engrossed, by the following vote:

AYES, 15—viz: Councilmen Austin, Burns, Cooper, Coy, Dunn, Hicklin, Markey, Martindale, Murphy, Myers, Olsen, Pearson, Rassmann, Sweetland, and Trusler.

NAYS, 4—viz: Councilmen Gauss, Nolan, Sherer, and Weber.

On motion, G. O. 27, 1891, was then read the third time and passed, by the following vote:

AYES, 15—viz: Councilmen Austin, Burns, Cooper, Coy, Dunn, Hicklin, Markey, Martindale, Murphy, Myers, Olsen, Pearson, Rassmann, Sweetland, and Trusler.

NAYS, 4—viz: Councilmen Gauss, Nolan, Sherer, and Weber.

On motion, the Common Council then adjourned.
