

PROCEEDINGS OF COMMON COUNCIL.

SPECIAL SESSION—SEPTEMBER 22, 1891.

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCES.

The following Appropriation Ordinance was read second time, ordered engrossed, and then read the third time.

Ap. O. No. 7, 1891.—An ordinance appropriating moneys for the purpose of defraying the current expenses of the city government of the City of Indianapolis, Indiana, for the fiscal year ending August 31st, 1892, including all outstanding obligations or claims which become due or payable within said period.
