April 26, 1852

Council met pursuant to adjournment. Present Messrs. Woodward, Loudon, Buchanan, Edwards, Pitts & Culley, President. Minutes read and approved.

Mr. Pitts offered for adoption the following resolution:

"Resolved, That we the City Council loan to W.C. King, & James H. Kennedy contractors for the City School houses, the sum of four hundred dollars of School Fund, to be secured by the applicants' notes, with interest from date negotiable and payable in the Branch Bank at Indianapolis. Note to be drawn to become due September 1852". Which was adopted.

The petition of Garratt Davis & Co. and others praying for the privilege of erecting a frame building within the limit of the prescribed limits of the city, within which no frame building is permitted to be erected, was, on motion indefinitely postponed.

Mr. Loudon offered for adoption the following resolution:

Resolved That an extra allowance of fifty dollars be made to Sins A. Colley, Marshall of the City for his services the past year, for the purpose of paying his assistant during the past year. (539-540)

Which was adopted by the following vote. **Ayes:** Messrs. Loudon, Buchanan, Edwards, Pitts, Woodward & Culley, President. **Nays,** None.

Mr. Buchanan offered for adoption the following resolution:

Resolved That a sum not exceeding Seventy five dollars of the fire tax fund not otherwise appropriated, be appropriated for painting the Marion Fire Engine and Hose wagon. Which was adopted.

On motion adjourned to meet again on Friday evening.
