"To the Honorable the City Council of Indianapolis:

The undersigned begs leave to state to this body that the Council of 1851 passed an order by an unanimous vote ordering Mr.Harvey Bates to fill up a hole or pit which he got dug by petitioners' house, in a lane running between Out lots Nos. 71 & 72 in this city by reason of which petitioners house is undermined, who wants to know what steps to take in order to obtain redress.

For the particulars of this case look at the proceedings of the meeting of the Council of April 7, 1851.

Ordered, That the City Engineer examines the alley next to Patrick Barrett & report to street commissioner

Referred to committee on streets & alleys & Councilman of 7th Ward

Mr.Louden presented a scale of prices for town clocks, which was ordered to be filed

On Motion it was

Ordered That the Councilman in 7th ward be directed to have a sidewalk made in front of Cumberland alley along East Street.
