

PROCEEDINGS OF COMMON COUNCIL.

ADJOURNED SESSION—APRIL 18, 1882.

The Common Council of the City of Indianapolis met in the Council Chamber, Tuesday evening, April 18th, A. D. 1882, at half-past seven o'clock, in adjourned session.

PRESENT—Hon. Daniel W. Grubbs, Mayor, and *ex officio* President of the Common Council, in the Chair, and 12 members, viz: Councilmen Bedford, Brundage, Caylor, Cole, Coy, Dean, Egger, Koller, Morrison, Pritchard, Thalman, and Yoke.

ABSENT—Councilmen Bryce, Cowie, Dowling, Fultz, Harrold, Hartmann, Knodel, Mauer, Pearson, Reichwein, Stout, Ward, and Weaver—13.

There being no quorum present, Councilman Pritchard moved that the Common Council adjourn to meet again next Monday night, April 24th, 1882.

Councilman Yoke moved to amend the above motion so as to make G. O. 19, 1882, a special order.

Which amendment was accepted by Councilman Pritchard.

The motion was then adopted, and the Common Council declared adjourned, to meet again Monday evening, April 24th, 1882.
