Mr. Blumberg called for General Ordinance No. 1, 1913, for second reading. It was read a second time.

Mr. Owen moved that General Ordinance No. 1, 1913, be stricken from the files.

Noes, 3, viz.: Messrs. Johnson, Rubens and President Charles F. Copeland.
