REGULAR SESSION.

CHAMBER OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF INDIANAPOLIS,
MONDAY, OCTOBER 7TH, 1867, 7 O'CLOCK, P. M. }

The Common Council met in regular session.

Present—Hon. Sims A. Colley, President *pro tem.*, in the chair,
and the following members :

Councilmen Brown, Burgess, Coburn, Colley, Cottrell, Davis, Foster,
Geisel, MacArthur, Stanton and Woodburn.—11.

Absent—Councilmen Goddard, Henschen, Jameson, Kappes,
Loomis, Schmidt and Seidensticker.—7.

The proceedings of the regular session, held September 30th, 1867,
were read and approved.

Mr. Brown moved, that the vote ordering a precept against
Morrison, et al., in favor of John Schier, for grading and paving with
brick, the north sidewalk on Louisiana street, between Meridian and
Illinois streets, be reconsidered.

Mr. MacArthur called for the ayes and noes.

The question being on the motion to reconsider, those who voted
in the affirmative were Councilmen Brown, Burgess, Coburn, Colley,
Cottrell, Davis, Foster, Geisel, Stanton and Woodburn:—10.

Councilman MacArthur voting in the negative.
So the motion to reconsider, was adopted.

On motion by Mr. Brown, the sealed proposals were referred to the Board of Public Improvements without reading.

On motion by Mr. MacArthur, the Council adjourned until Wednesday evening, October 9th, 1867, at 7 o'clock.
