### **SPECIAL ORDERS—PUBLIC HEARING**

The President called for proposals eligible for public hearing. Members of the public were invited to be heard on proposals eligible for public hearing. The Committee recessed to the Committee of the Whole at 7:11 p.m., and reconvened at 7:15 p.m.

*Fiscal Ordinance No. 3, 1975.* After public hearing, during which Dr. Murrill Lowry, Director, Department of Public Safety, spoke regarding Fiscal Ordinance No. 3, 1975, Councilman Robbins moved, seconded by Councilman Tintera to amend Fiscal Ordinance No. 3, 1975, as follows:

## CITY-COUNTY COUNCIL MOTION

Mr. President:

I move that Police Special Service District Fiscal Ordinance No. 3, 1975, be amended as follows:

In Section 3, Line 4, under INDIANAPOLIS POLICE FORCE-column reading POLICE SERVICE DISTRICT FUND-10. Services Personal by deleting the figures \$139,000 and inserting in lieu thereof the figures \$188,000.

In Section 3, by deleting Line 5, 21. Services Contractual, \$1,000 in its entirety.

In Section 3, by deleting the figures in Line 6, 50. Capital Outlay \$60,000 and inserting in lieu thereof the figures \$12,000.

No Noes. Mr. Tintera was out of Chambers during voting. Fiscal Ordinance No. 3, 1975, reads as follows:

POLICE SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT FISCAL ORDINANCE  
NO. 3, 1975 AS AMENDED

A FISCAL ORDINANCE amending the Police Force Budget for 1975  
(Police Special Service District Fiscal Ordinance No. 7, 1974)

and appropriating the additional sum of Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00) in the Police Special Service District Fund for certain purposes of the Indianapolis Police Force for purposes of the Community Development programs and reducing the unappropriated and unencumbered balance of the Police Service District Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE POLICE SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDIANAPOLIS:

Section 1. To provide for expenditures the necessity for which has arisen since the adoption of the annual budget, the Police Force Budget for 1975 be, and is hereby, amended by the increases and reductions hereinafter stated for the purposes of Community Development projects financed by federal grants made pursuant to the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974.

Section 2. The sum of Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00) be, and the same is hereby, appropriated for the purposes as shown in Section 3 by reducing the unappropriated Police Service District Fund as shown in Section 4.

Section 3. The following additional appropriations are hereby approved:

Section 4. The said additional appropriations are funded by the following reductions:

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, following public hearing, approval by the Mayor, and approval by the State Board of Tax Commissioners.

POLICE SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT FISCAL ORDINANCE  
NO. 4, 1975

A FISCAL ORDINANCE amending the Police Force Budget for 1975 (Police Special Service District Fiscal Ordinance No. 7, 1974) and appropriating the additional sum of Four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) in the Police Service District Fund for certain purposes of the Indianapolis Police Force and reducing the unappropriated and unencumbered balance of the Police Service District Fund and transferring and appropriating Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) in Federal Revenue Sharing Funds for such purposes.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE POLICE SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDIANAPOLIS:

Section 1. To provide for expenditures the necessity for which has arisen since the adoption of the annual budget, the Police Force Budget for 1975 be, and is hereby, amended by the increases and reductions hereinafter stated to authorize the purchase of additional police automobiles.

Section 2. The sum of Four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000)

be, and the same is hereby, appropriated for the purposes as shown in Section 3 by reducing the appropriations in the Police Service District Fund as shown in Section 4 and by reallocation of revenues as provided in Section 5.

Section 3. The following additional appropriations are hereby approved:

Section 4. The said additional appropriations are funded by the following reductions:

	TOTAL REDUCTIONS	\$400,000.00

Section 5. The City-County Annual Budget for 1975 (City-County Fiscal Ordinance No. 42, 1974) be and is hereby further amended to appropriate and allocate the additional sum of Two hundred Fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000.00) from the Revenue Sharing Trust Fund to the Police Service District Fund and amending Section 7 of the Annual Budget by deleting in paragraph (b) the words and figures "Four million five hundred twenty-four thousand three hundred forty-one dollars (\$4,524,341.00)" and inserting in lieu thereof the words and figures "Four million seven hundred seventy-four thousand three hundred forty-one dollars (\$4,774,341.00)."

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after adoption, following public hearing, approval by the Mayor, and approval by the State Board of Tax Commissioners.
