

Council Chamber
June 21. 1839

Council met, upon call of two members. Prest. Lockerbie Sullivan, McCluer and Norwood.

Mr. Lockerbie in the chair.

James Vanblaricum presented his Bond as Collector of the Revenue in the town of Indianapolis which was approved.

Mr. Wm. J. Dawson presented an account for work done on grave yard, which was referred to a committee consisting of Messrs Norwood & Sullivan.

On Motion of Mr. McCluer

Resolved That the Supervisor cause Potomac Alley between Pennsylvania and Delaware Streets to be filled up and drained under the direction of the Councilman from the Second Ward.

Allowed Hervey Brown thirty dollars for services as Clerk to the Committee appointed to revise the Ordinances.

(Issued July 13. 1839)

On Motion of Mr. Sullivan

Resolved, That the Secretary be directed to procure a suitable book in which to Record the Ordinances of the Common Council.
