Indianapolis August 4, 1840

Council met: present Henry P. Coburn Esqr. President Messrs Goldsberry, Cox, Seibert, Norwood & Loudon Councilmen.

The Treasurer made his monthly report which was accepted and adopted.

Mr. Seibert from Committee on Engines made a report which was adopted.

Mr. A Grover presented a petition on the subject of a Blacksmith Shop,

Ordered that said petition be not granted.

On Motion of Mr. Cox

Resolved That \$50. be appropriated for the purpose of filling and repairing Circle Street in the 3rd Ward also fifty dollars for culverts at the crossing of Illinois and Maryland Streets and for a foot bridge on Illinois Street at the junction of Indiana Avenue.

On Motion of Mr. Goldsberry

Resolved That \$25: be appropriated for the purpose of constructing culverts in the second Ward.

On Motion of Mr. Cox

Ordered That the fine assessed against Wm. Garver by the President of the Common Council, for violating Grocery Ordinance be remitted.

Ordered That the Secretary issue orders to each of the officers of the Council for their first quarters salary  
(Issud)

Allowed Fultz & Co \$25: in addition to what they have received on contract to fill and grade streets in the second ward which said \$25. is to be drawn for and paid on the fifteenth day of October next.
