Indianapolis July 30. 1841

Council met; present a full Council.

N.B. Palmer and others presented a petition on the subject of taxes wherupon on Motion of Mr. Norwood

Ordered That the Collector proceed only to collect three fifths (fifteen cents on each hundred dollars) of the tax (except the Poll tax and dog tax) heretofore assessed against each person on the tax list and on each piece & article of property enumerated and placed in his hands for collection.

On Motion of Mr Cox

Ordered That all the work in the town under the supervision of the Supervisor on the Streets be immediately & entirely suspended

John Montgomery presented a petition on the subject of the losses sustained by him while in the employ of the Council Whereupon ordered that he be allowed \$4:50 as renumeration for such loss
