Indianapolis October 6. 1841

Council met; present a full council:

The President made his second quarterly report which was adopted

The Treasurer made his monthly report which was adopted.

The Marshal made his monthly report which was adopted & James Vanblaricum Marshal allowed on said report \$8:87½ cts
(Isd 7. Oct)

The Market Master of the East Market made his monthly report which was adopted.

The Market Master of the West Market made his monthly report which was adopted

The Supervisor made his monthly report which was refered to the committee heretofore appointed on that subject.

The Weigh Master made his monthly report which was adopted

Isaac N Phipps asked and obtained leave to take earth from the walks on Meredian Street where there may be a surplus under the direction of Goldsberry & Loudon, to make walks with

Mr. Boatright from the committee on that subject Reported that said committee had fixed the grade of pavements near the crossing of Washington & Illinois ten inches above the centre of Washington Street to be at the curb four inches above said centre

Whereupon on motion said committee was continued with directions to superintend the improvement at said crossing of Washington & Illinois Streets.

H P Coburn presented a petition on the subject of the alley running through Block number 38 which was granted and said H P Coburn permitted to grade said alley under the direction of Mr. Goldsberry as a committee.

An Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance authorizing the appointment of town of Auctioneer." was reported amended and passed and ordered to be published

Allowed Cutler and Chamberlin \$2:50 as per account filed for printing

The committee on the Hose carriage reported and were discharged Whereupon

Allowed Henry Gaston \$150 for Hose carriage as per account (Isd. 7 Oct.)

On Motion of Mr. Goldsberry

Ordered the committee on the Hook & Ladder Company be directed make a Hook & ladder wagon out the old Hose Carriage

Ordered That the collector be authorized to correct Wm. Y Wileys amount of tax for the year 1841

The committee on Maryland Street reported that James Green the contractor on said street had completed his job

Whereupon James Green was allowed the sum of \$257:82 in full of said contract:

Also allowed said James Green the sum of 23:37 for work on Market & Circle Streets making in all \$281:19 for which said sum of \$281:19 the Secretary is ordered on the request of said Green to issue orders to the following persons and in the following amounts
