Council met: present Messrs Culley President Black Goldsberry Nowland Loudon Rickards and Rooker of the Council

Ordered That one dollar be withheld and deducted from Mr Loudons salary as Councilman in consequence of his absence from Council on 3rd December 1842

Mr Black from committee on claims reported back the accounts in favor of Benjamin Pottage and recommended the allowance of \$4:56 in full of said accounts = Allowed B Pottage \$4:36 in full of said claims for Hardware etc. the balance having been paid.

The President laid before the Council the Weighmasters monthly report also the Treasurers monthly report which were severally received.

Mr. Rickards presented the Petition of the Hook & ladder company on the subject of ropes for use of said company when on motion of Mr. Richards

Resolved That the committee on the Fire department be directed to purchase ropes suitable for the use of said company.

On Motion of Mr Goldsberry

Resolved That the Marshal together with the committee on the Fire department be directed procure 300 feet of hose of the Marion Engine Company to be used by the Good Intent Fire Company until hose can be purchased for the fire department
