Council met: present all the members of the Council.

Mr Nowland presented the petition of W Little and others on the subject of Hogs: which on motion of Mr Rooker was refered to select committee with instructions to report an ordinance to repeal an ordinance entitled An ordinance to regulate hogs running at large in the town of Indianapolis ordained and established 1st October 1842 - Messrs Rooker Goldsberry & Rickards were appointed said committee - whereupon Mr Rooker from said select committee reported An ordinance to repeal An ordinance entitled an ordinance to regulate hogs running at large in the town of Indianapolis ordained and established October 1st 1842 which report was concurred in and said ordinance read amended ordained and passed and ordered to be published.
