Indianapolis March 27. 1843

Council met Messrs Black Nowland and Records of the Council present -

Mr David V. Culley Presented his commission as President of the Common Council and took his seat as such.

Messrs Samuel Goldsberry councilman elect for the second ward & Andrew A Loudon Councilman elect for the fourth ward and Samuel S Rooker Councilman elect for the sixth ward presented their certificates of election, was sworn into office and took their seats as Councilmen.

Ordered That the Salary of the Secretary for the coming year be fixed at one hundred and twenty five dollars.

Ordered That the Salary of the Treasurer for the coming year be fixed at Sixty five dollars

Ordered That the Salary of the Marshal for the coming year be fixed at one hundred dollars

Ordered That the Salary of the Supervisor for the coming year be fixed at one hundred dollars

Ordered That the Salary of each Clerk of the Market for the coming year be fixed at fifty dollars

On motion of Mr. Recharé

Resolved That the Collector for the coming year be allowed a per centum on the amount which may be collected by him, which per centum shall be hereafter fixed by the Council

And the Council adjourned to meet on 31st March 1843 at one oclock P.M.
