

Council Chamber
Indianapolis, January 6th 1844.

Council met: All the members present but Mr. Rooker.

Messrs. Louden, Nowland, and Rickards were excused for being absent from the last two meetings.

Mr. Louden presented the Treasurers and Weighmasters monthly reports, which were read and received.

196. The account of Ballenger and Monteeth for \$3.50 was taken from the table and allowed.

The President laid before the Council his quarterly report of proceeding had before him, for said quarter, ending January 6th 1844: and also his account of fees for said quarter, which was read and received.

217. Allowed D. V. Culley President \$2.68, the amount of his account for fees for one quarter, ending January 6th 1844.

Mr. Rickards from the committee on that subject, reported an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance declaring certain houses public nuisances, and for other purposes", which was read, amended and passed: and the Secretary ordered to have the same published.

Mr. Black moved to repeal the amendment to the ordinance entitled "An Ordinance to restrain the licensing of Groceries and Tippling houses, and for other purposes", ordained and established December 2nd, 1843, which was negatived.

Naes - Messrs. Louden, Nowland and Rickards.

Messrs Ready and Huffman made application for grocery license: when Mr. Louden moved to grant such license for fifteen months, commencing on the 27th day of August 1843, for \$100. which prevailed; And the Secretary ordered to issue such license upon said applicants complying with the ordinances on that subject.

175. Allowed Sam. Goldsberry \$10.50 for hauling gravel, and work done on lower Markethouse as per acp.

202. Allowed E. Hedderly \$1.50 for oil furnished fire department as per acp. filed.

201. Allowed George Shearer \$5.37 $\frac{1}{2}$ for repairing pumps and materials furnished as per acp. filed.
