Proceedings of the City Council

Council Chamber
Indianapolis, May 14" 1847.

The Council met upon call. --Present a full council, except Mr Cady -

The President laid before the council a Report of the Treasurer relative to the condition of the General Fund & Road Monies, which was read, received, & filed.

Ordered "That the condition of the bond of the Treasurer, be in substance as follows viz. "That if the said Treasurer, will well, truly, and faithfully, discharge all and singular his duties as such Treasurer of the city aforesaid, as prescribed in the charter of said city and the laws & ordinances of the city council aforesaid, that are now in force, or may hereafter be passed by said council, during his continuance in Office as such Treasurer. and at the expiration of his term of Office deliver over to his successor in Office, all books, papers, monies, or other property of whatsoever kind or description, belonging to the city of Indianapolis, then and in that case, the above obligation shall cease and be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in law.
