Council Chamber
Indianapolis Nov 12, 1849

The Council met, Present Wm. Eckert President, Messrs Bates, Culley, Sulgrove and Montague.

(410) Mr. Bates from the Committee on claims to who was referred the the account of Morrison and Talbott of \$4.83 for stationary, reported the same back recommending a deduction of \$2.08 for articles got by Ex Mayor Henderson, and that the remainder of said account towit \$2.75 be allowed.

On Motion, The report was concurred in and the allowance of \$2.75 made accordingly.

Mr Culley moved that the Street Commissioner be directed to make foot bridges at the crossing of Delaware Street at northern inter-section with Washington Street - also across the gutter on the east side of Alabama Street north of Market Street, and gravel the mouth of the alley on the east side of Delaware Street, south of Washington
Adopted.

Mr President, moved that the street Commissioner be directed to cleanse out the gutter on the south side of Washington Street, opposite lots No 4, 5, & 6 in Sqr 66, and gravel said gutter, and to open the drain on same side of Washington Street, opposite the State house square-
Adopted.

Mr Bates, from the Committee on Claims who were charged with the duty of loaning the school fund, reported the following loans as having been effected towit

To Edwin J Pech \$400.00 for 4 Months from Nov. 12, 49 with Jacob Vandegrift and John Greer as sureties.

To Hood & Noble \$400.00 for 4 Months from Nov. 12, 49 with T S Allen & Co. & J S. Pratt & I R Osgood as sureties.

On Motion by Mr Bates, the foregoing loans were confirmed and the sureties approved.

Sundry other applications for loans were presented pending which Mr Montague retired from the Chamber, and therefore no quorum being present,

The council adjourned.
