

# PROCEEDINGS OF BOARD OF ALDERMEN.

ADJOURNED SESSION—SEPTEMBER 9, 1885.

The Board of Aldermen of the City of Indianapolis, met in the Aldermanic Chamber, Wednesday afternoon, September 9th, 1885, at two o'clock, pursuant to adjournment.

PRESENT—Hon. Brainard Rorison, President of the Board of Aldermen, in the Chair, and Aldermen Bernhamer, Endly, King, Pritchard, and Tallentire—6.

ABSENT, 4—viz. Aldermen Cobb, Cox, McHugh, and Prier.

The following ordinance was read the second and third times:

O. 33, 1885—An ordinance amending an ordinance entitled "An ordinance dividing the various Wards of the City of Indianapolis into voting precincts," by providing that the Second Ward be divided into three voting precincts, and changing the boundaries of the Tenth Ward voting precincts.

And it was passed by the following vote:

AYES, 6—viz. Aldermen Bernhamer, Endly, King, Pritchard, Tallentire, and President Rorison.

NAYS—None.
