Half-page image area: 10 x 7½ horizontal format

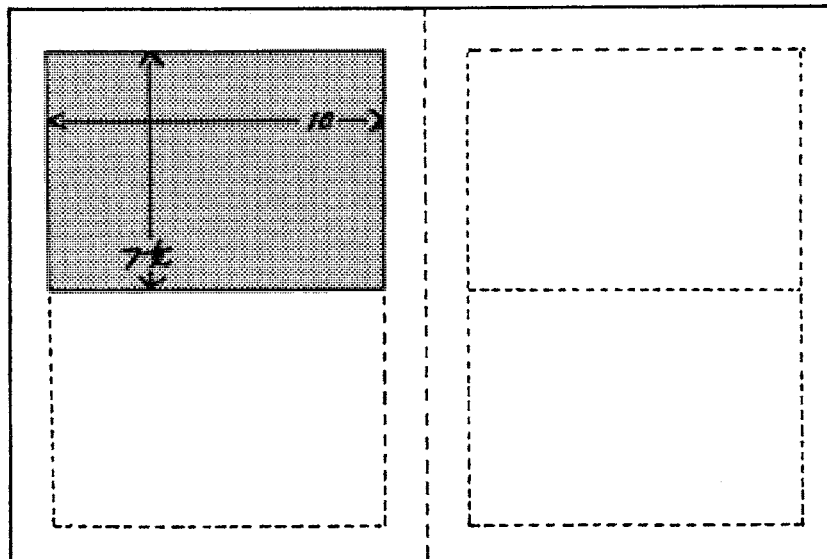
Use black and white copy.
